President's Notes

Summer has arrived for the Canterbury Club. I hope everyone has had the opportunity to visit and enjoy the pool.

Several physical improvements have been made this spring. New carpet is being installed on the porch. Thank you to Rob Cleary for donating the cost of installation. The wooden fencing around the baby pool has been stained and Diane has applied a product called Restore Concrete to provide a rough surface to the previously slippery concrete pads. The tree stumps were removed this spring and sod has been placed where the trees once stood. The sod was donated by Jack Winans.

The balance on the mortgage, \$11,000, which was due in March of 2013, was voted by the board at the May meeting to be paid in full. This action will save the club the monthly interest that was being paid on the loan. Even though the mortgage is paid in full the club's financial issues still exist. As the facility ages there will continue to be more repairs needed to the existing structures. A financial committee is forming in June to

assist the club with long and short term financial goals. The committee plans to meet every other month. I encourage you to consider becoming a member of this committee. The committee will be led by board treasurer Amy Iliff and Mike Weissling, CPA.

Swim lessons will be offered this year from June 11-22. Age groups and times are 4-5 year olds, 11:30 to noon; 6-7 year olds, 11:00 to 11:30am; 8-9 year olds, 10:30 to 11:00am and ages 10 and up from 9:45 to 10:30am. Lessons will be taught by Club Manager Diane Mosser and the lifeguards. Lessons for stock members are free. Non-stock members may take lessons for \$20.00 per swimmer and non-members for \$25.00 per swimmer.

Internet service will be available at the pool beginning June 1. It will be password protected. Please ask a board member, the guards, or Diane for the password.

There will be a swim team meeting in late May/early June at the pool. (please watch your email for time and date.) Your chances to have your kids try on swim suits and place your order for the team suit are Saturday, May 5, and Sunday, May 6, from 2-4 p.m. at the pool In the event of cold and/or rainy weather (like last year) I will have the try on at First Presbyterian on Saturday, May 5 from 9 a.m. – noon. Aquatic Adventures offers a 25% discount for suit orders made on the try on days. ***Keep in mind your child does not have to wear a swim team suit to participate in the meets.*** If you have any questions I can answer them at that time or at the parent meeting.

Stingray parents must participate in home and away meets. **Each team must provide timers, runners, bull pen coordinators, and a stroke judge. Concession volunteers are also needed for home meets.** Sign up sheets will be posted at the sign in table at Canterbury and online at least one week prior to the meet for swimmers and volunteers. Sign ups must be complete the Sunday before the meet. This is very important and makes the meets run smoothly. We cannot run the meets without your help.

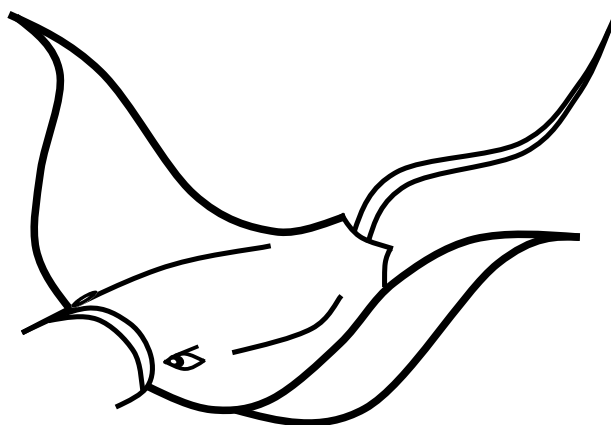
